## The sunflower expert

For harvesting with high capacity and minimal loss.



### Minimal harvest loss

Very long pans for minimum crop loss and row independent harvest. The gaps are easy to adjust to the thickness of the stems.



### Perfect cut

The tear roll under the knife pulls the stems downwards from the header. Only the sunflower heads are cut off.







#### Row independent

The SOLERO works row independently and is therefore suitable for different row distances: e.g. 70/75/80 cm or even 50 cm.



#### Excellent feeding

The adjustable finger reel ensures smooth crop flow to the feeding auger and prevents blockage between pans and the cutting knife.



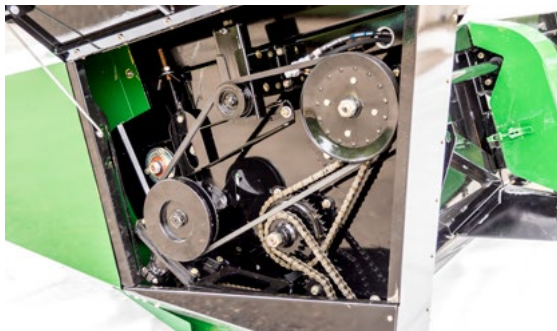
#### Gentle Harvest

Gentle „guiding“ of the plants by the rotatable frontline roll prevents early cutting. Only sunflower heads get into the threshing system. This provides a minimum of stems and a clean seeds in the grain tank.



#### Easy adjustment

The frontline roll is hydraulically height adjustable, for an optimized feeding of the plants.



#### Highest reliability

The SOLERO is solid and stable, but not heavy. Also reliable in operation and convenient in use due less rotating parts.



#### Universal use

Fitting adapter frames are available for attaching the ZÜRN SOLERO to combines of all common brands.
